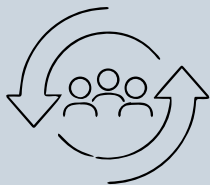

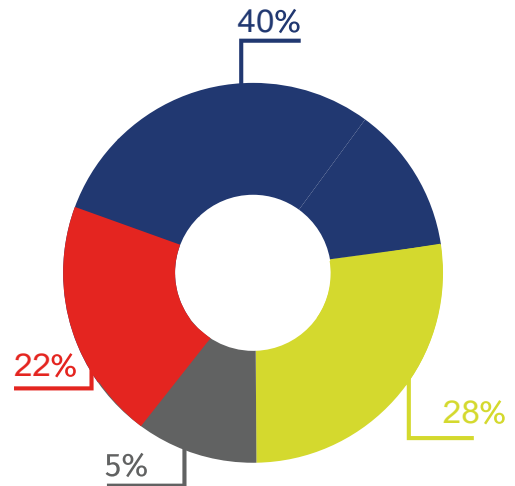
- 40% of all donations assist in poverty alleviation
